

## **GREAT FAMILIES 2020**

- » Two Community Connectors have been hired to be placed at Daystar & Little Dove Daycare to help families access neighborhood resources & services
- » Families can sign up to participate in Great Families 2020 on September 1, 2017

## THOMAS GREGG NEIGHBORHOOD SCHOOL

- » Hired over 60 staff members to support school missions & operations
- » Supported by 10 member board of directors who live and work in the neighborhood
- » Staff participated in a two week training institute
- » 525 students enrolled

### 21<sup>ST</sup> CENTURY COMMUNITY LEARNING CENTERS

- » The Learning Center has offered 36 different health, nutrition, physical education, leadership building, & enrichment programs
- » The Learning Center supports summer programs to prevent summer learning loss
- » The Learning Center offers parent engagement and learning opportunities

# HOUSING STABILITY FOR SCHOOL SUCCESS

- » 65 units reserved for families with at least one child at School #14 or TGNS, attending 3<sup>rd</sup> grade or less, & has experienced housing instability as an effort to minimize student mobility
- » JBNC is purchasing property in order to build an apartment building that will house about 30 additional families from TGNS in an effort to expand the program to more families facing housing instability

#### **EDGE AFTERSCHOOL**

- » 65% of students participated in programs teaching STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Math) (\*average statistic from 3 elementary sites)
- » 65% of students enjoyed their STEM programs (\*average statistic from 3 elementary sites)
- » 100% of coordinators participate in 10 hours of professional development to facilitate quality STEM learning

# NEAR EASTSIDE EDUCATION AMERICORPS

- » Since the switch to social-emotional programming for neighborhood youth for the 2016-2017, 199 students participated in receiving behavior services
- » Since the programming, 69% of students showed improvement in their socialemotional behaviors
- » Near Eastside Educational AmeriCorps will start offering social-emotional programming in early childhood education settings

# CENTER FOR WORKING FAMILIES

- » The CWF helps low-income individuals and families get jobs, strengthen their finances and move up the economic ladder
- » The Family Strengthening initiative focuses on increasing financial stability for families
- » UWCI has invested in the JBNC's CWF model to expand programming
- » In 2016, the Near Eastside Career Opportunities Center opened & offers adult educational opportunities (i.e. GED; BOI-REDi; IndyPlan)

#### **BEST BABIES ZONE**

- » Awarded the Kohl's Cares Grant supporting safe sleep efforts & professional development
- » Supporting home-based daycares in area code 46201 in efforts to move PTQ centers from levels 1 & 2 to 3 & 4
- » Forming partnerships with public safety professionals to create a community of practice through a healthy lens
- » July 12, 2017: BBZ team held a Public Safety & Infant Mortality luncheon

# EARLY CHILDHOOD COMPREHENSIVE SYSTEMS COLLABORATIVE IMPROVEMENT & INNOVATION NETWORK

- » Group of partners (Goodwill's NFP, Healthy Families, Healthy Start, WIC, First Steps, SafetyPin, UWCI, Early Learning Indiana, CWF) with goal of 25% increase in developmental screens for birth - 3 years by January 2018
- » National Help Me Grow will be integrated into MOM's Help Line, Promise Zone will be one of 8 pilot sites
- » WIC will be moving into JBNC in effort to serve 600-800 families locally
