

## Parent/Youth EDGE Health and Safety Disclosures

- 1. Students will be required to wear their face mask at all times except during the allotted break and meal times given to them by their youth worker.
  - a. Suppose a youth worker or student were to answer yes to any question on the questionnaire at the beginning or end of the day or have a temperature in fever range. In that case, that person is to stay home for the self-quarantine period of 14 days and can return to any in-person engagement activity once the period is over AND with a doctor's note of clearance.
  - b. Youth workers and students should provide their own mask. If they do not have one, one will be provided for them.
  - c. Students should have their mask labeled with their name in permanent marker.
  - d. Parents should wear their mask at all times; including drop off and pick up of student.
  - e. Students will be required to wear their mask while on JBNC transportation and follow social distancing guidelines.

## If students do not uphold the expectations with face coverings:

Step One: We will proceed with a restorative mindset—students are hearing conflicting information from families, school, news, etc. As much as possible, we will pursue the opportunity for teachable moments.

Step Two: Proceed with verbal reminders and visual cues for wearing face coverings.

Step Three: Involve the site coordinator.

Step Four: The parent will be notified; the director will document the conversation with a parent.

- 1. Youth Workers and students are to bring their own water bottles. Shared water will not be provided (i.e. water fountains, coolers, etc.) Please mark your students water bottle with a permanent marker.
- 2. Youth Workers and students will not be permitted to sharing or serving food and beverages to one another.
- 3. If items were to be shared, a checklist of cleaning those items will be completed after use.
