NEIGHBORHOOD ENGAGEMENT provides our neighbors a platform to determine initiatives ways to enhance the quality of life for the community.

In 2015, John Boner Neighborhood Center led a coalition of partners that secured the Promise Zone designation for the Near Eastside. This 10 year federal designation is for selected communities with high poverty AND high capacity to target resources to address economic development, crime, education and leverage private capital. The selected goals for Indy-East Promise Zone include:

LIVE INDY EAST (Create Affordable Housing Options)


WORK INDYEAST (Job Creation)

Within 9 months of being named a Promise Zone, \$7.3 million in federal grants were awarded - \$ organizations received this benefit - Funding from \$ federal agencies were secured.
