## 2020 HIGHLIGHTS

### COVID-19 Resources, Union Apartments

In 2020 our world was turned upside down. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the buildings were closed most of the year. However, we still needed a way to support and reach our neighbors. Our newly launched website provided access to much-needed resources and programs virtually. We also made our intake form available electronically to allow continued support. In addition, to support the many Marion County households who lost income due to the pandemic, we also launched the IndyRent program with the City of Indianapolis. In 2020 alone, the program received more than 15,000 applications and distributed over \$33 million in rental assistance.

We also opened our first family-centered, affordable apartment complex in partnership with Thomas Gregg Neighborhood School called The Union Apartments. This housing model provides on-site wrap-around services and programming for students and families.

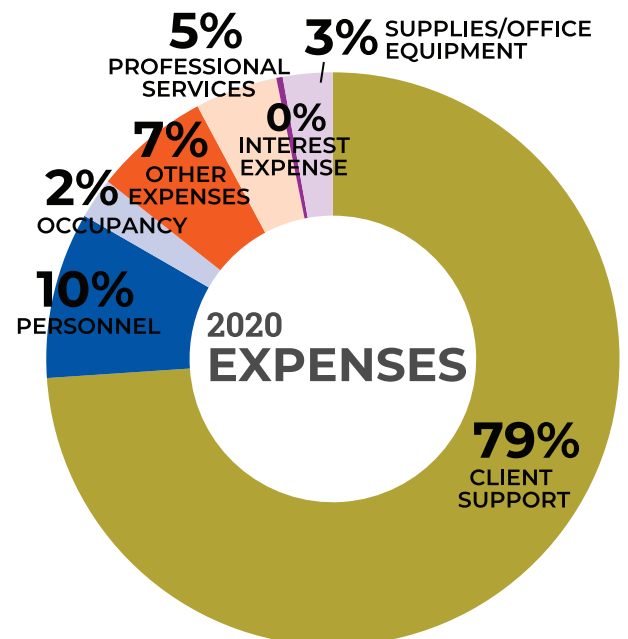
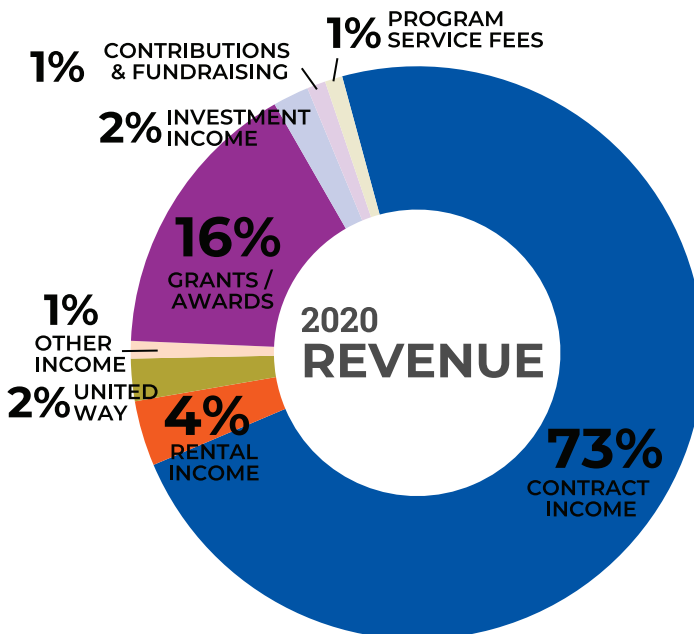
