2021 marked 50 years of serving neighbors on the Near Eastside for John Boner Neighborhood Centers. From the humble beginnings of a simple folding table and chair to a thriving community connector, we have grown to offer programs, services, and initiatives that improve neighbors' quality of life daily. In October, we celebrated this milestone anniversary with a visual history displayed on our building's windows along 10th Street, a competitive scavenger hunt, collaborative legacy art project, and neighborhood block party. Near the end of 2021, we were awarded a five-year, \$30 million grant to create the IndyEast Promise Neighborhood. Promise Neighborhoods is responsive, student-centered initiative that creates an environment where the whole family can thrive, be healthy, and prosper. It promises all students on the Near Eastside and in Martindale-Brightwood access to great schools and whole family support to ensure a successful transition from cradle to career.

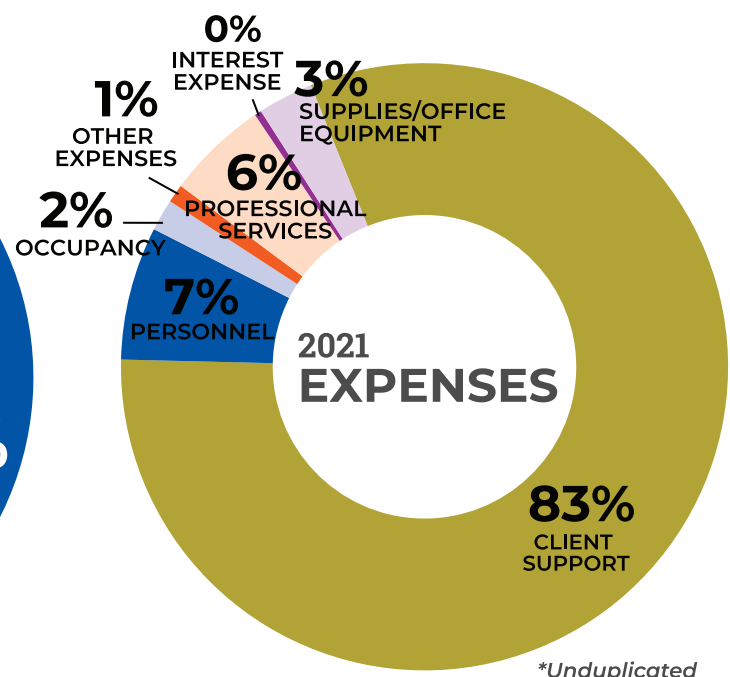
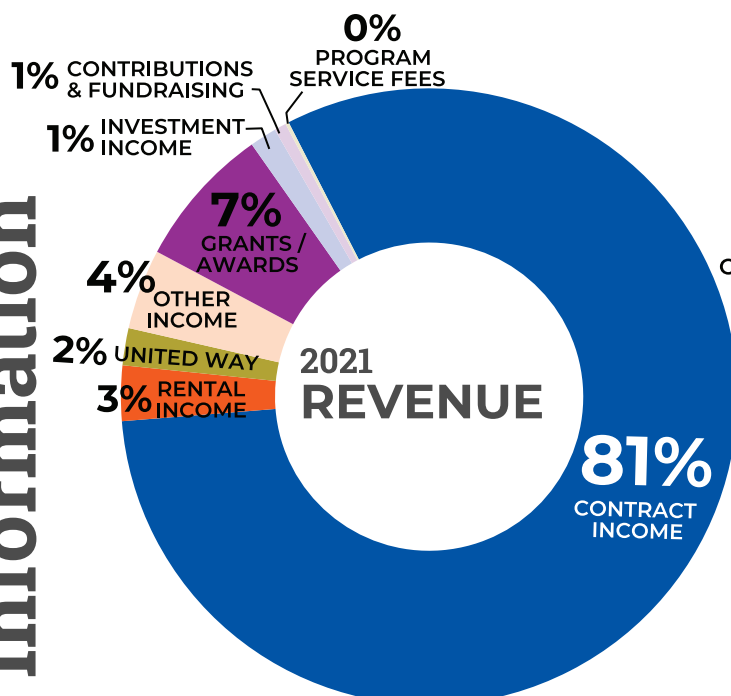
