

Consent To Disclose Information to the VITA Programs Relational Offices

Federal Disclosure:

Federal law requires this consent form be provided to you ("you" refers to each taxpayer, if more than one). Unless authorized by law, we cannot disclose, without your consent, your tax return information to third parties for purposes other than the preparation and filing of your tax return. If you consent to the disclosure of your return information, Federal law may not protect your tax return information from further use or distribution.

You are not required to complete this form to engage in our tax return preparation services. If we obtain your signature on this form by conditioning our services on your consent, your consent will not be valid. If you agree to the disclosure of your tax return information, your consent is valid for the amount of time that you specify. If you do not specify the duration of your consent, your consent is valid for one year from the date of signature.

Terms:

3 Years – Disclosure: Tax Preparer will disclose the Personal Information to the Software Developer through Software Developer's tax preparation software. The Software Developer will disclose the Personal Information to the VITA program Relational Offices.

3 Years – Purpose: The purpose of the Disclosures is for the Software Developer to make available the Taxpayer's Personal Information to the VITA program Relational Offices in order for them to provide support and administrative assistance to the Tax Preparer.

Use: To determine tax return filing method. Choose one option only.
